### S4 Study Skills Sessions

S5 and S6 pupils led study skills sessions with all our S4 pupils on 1 November. S4 came to the assembly hall in register classes and broke into groups to carousel round different stations where they learned the different techniques and apps that helped S5 and S6 prepare for their exams last year. All S4 also received a study pack with resources such as flashcards, dry wipe boards and highlighters. The pupils were really motivated by the sessions and left eager to start their revision!

### Youth Speaks Competition

Kyle entered three teams in the Rotary Club's Youth Speaks debating competition this year. It was held on 3 November at Belmont Academy. The teams, coached by Ms Gillies in the English Dept, were outstanding and all three have progressed to the South West Scotland heats.
