Road Safety on Overmills Road

A reminder that there is restricted vehicle access to the playground after agreement with South Ayrshire Council. This is due to considerable concerns about the volume of traffic in the school playground at the start and end of the day which compromises the safety of our young people. **There is no vehicle access to the school playground between the following times.**

• 8.15 – 9.00 am every day

3.15 – 4.00 pm Monday and Tuesday
2.30 – 3.15 pm Wednesday to Friday

In addition, congestion on Overmills Road around the school entrance in the mornings and at the end of the day poses a safety issue for our young people and causes significant upset to local residents.

We ask parents/carers to avoid driving into Overmills Road if possible. Instead, drop off further from the school, for example, Holmston Road, and let your child walk the remaining distance to school.

The Ayrshire Roads Alliance has also asked me to remind parents that the laybys in Kilnford Crescent are passing places and should not be used for waiting. Please avoid parking in these spaces to allow a smooth traffic flow in the crescent and prevent congestion.

Police Scotland have advised that the following can be viewed as dangerous driving and should not happen under any circumstances.

- Using the school entrance to turn
- Reversing back into the school entrance
- Doing a u-turn on Overmills Road
- Ignoring the 20 mph speed limit on Overmills Road

I know that you will appreciate that these requests are for the safety of our pupils and our local community. If there is a reason your child requires to be dropped off in the school playground then please do not hesitate to contact us to make suitable arrangements.
