#### **SQA CERTIFICATION 2024**

Please note, option changes at this point should be due to exceptional circumstances, for example, failing to pass a course and requiring to resit that subject. It is important that we make all changes ahead of the start of the new term.

### **SQA Appeals Service 2024**

The appeals service has changed. The school no longer sends alternative evidence to SQA to be checked. Instead, pupils will have their SQA marked assessments reviewed by a qualified SQA marker. The school will only submit a review on behalf of pupils where the grade they receive on their SQA certificate is lower than their estimated grade. For example, the school will request a review where the estimate was a Grade B but SQA have awarded a Grade C.

It is important to note that grades can go up or stay the same or go down.
