## Choice of Courses for S3 moving into New S4 Pupils – Kyle Academy 2022-2023 – NOTES

1. Young people must choose 1 subject choice in each of the Columns - six subjects in total with a back up subject. **If an Options form is not returned or returned incomplete the school will make a selection for you based on your latest school report.**
2. In order to ensure the most efficient use of staff, classes with uptake of below 10 pupils are unlikely to run. In such situations, we may be able to amalgamate certain courses, but in other cases, pupils may have to select an alternative subject. In the first instance the Back Up Subject choice will be used.
3. A young person in S4 may wish to undertake Higher Level learning in S4. If this is applicable to you please speak to your Guidance teacher to discuss before entering this on your form.
4. College courses are timetabled in columns E and F, please speak to your Guidance teacher if you wish to apply for a School / College course 2 afternoons per week if you have a specific career pathway in mind.
