# *Study at college while still at school*

- We work in partnership with schools and employers to give young people the opportunity to study a college course as part of their school timetable.
- Courses are designed to enhance the school curriculum.
- Provide young people the opportunity to develop soft skills making them more work ready.



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# ***COLLEGE PROVISION***

- **Courses start in June when timetables change.**
- **The majority of classes start at 2.00 pm and finish at either 4.00 pm or 5.00 pm**
- **Travel to and from college is organised by the school with the exception of pupils travelling to Kilmarnock or Kilwinning campus for a Foundation Apprenticeship**
- **College will provide support to students with additional support needs which mirrors the support given in school**
